

## TAKING BACK THE LAND

We hear a lot about the separation of church and state these days. What has been forgotten is that this concept was introduced to stop the state interfering with churches, not the other way around. It would have been unthinkable in former times that Parliamentarians would not hold to Judaeo-Christian values. I knew Labour Speaker of the House and Australia's first Representative to the United Nations, Norman Makin. He was a Methodist lay-preacher and often took services in my home church. He told me that he and Alfred Deakin, Australia's second Prime Minister, used to lie on the banks of Canberra Creek to pray and read poetry between Parliamentary sessions. Now we have secular humanists telling us that religion has no place in government! What they really mean is that governments should be ruled by their elitist values and God be pushed out of the equation. Gough Whitlam is reported to have said: "When I meet my maker I want to treat him as an equal?"

Secular humanism rose to ascendancy in the mid-Nineteenth Century. Foremost in promoting their views has been Julian Huxley, first Director of UNESCO and founder of the Union for the Conservation of Nature (World Wildlife Fund). Julian Huxley argued that humans were evolving, as evidenced by the superiority of the Aryan races, and we could help evolution and see a super-human evolve quicker by disposing of inferior types. To help in this we needed to replace religion with naturalism, because religion was always trying to help the poor and disadvantaged when we should be concentrating on getting rid of them. In the early 1900s, Huxley directed the development of Humanist and Eugenics (human sterilisation) Societies. Bills were passed in most Western countries that allowed the state to sterilise 'inferior types', and these statues are still on the books! In the late 1990s the Peruvian Government sterilised over 300 000 Indians.

The Humanist doctrine is that humans can control their own destiny. The reality is that

under their management we have had continuous wars. In World War II Hitler made Aryan supremacy and eugenics unpopular by killing off Jews and disabled people so Huxley had to shift his attack on Christian values to environmentalism. The Climate Change/Global Warming agenda is nothing more than a project to reduce food supplies so that inferior types will starve, allowing evolution's superman to emerge sooner rather than later.

Are the secular-humanists right or is there a God who created the universe after all? That is the question we must all answer, because **our belief system dictates our values and our values dictate our decisions**. If over 60% of the Australian populace believe in God, we need to take back the land that we have lost by allowing the secular humanists to take over our Parliaments. And that means getting more Christians into Parliaments rather than less.
